

ABSTRACTS

Contributions are welcome on a wide range of topics within the field of agricultural, resource, environmental, and applied economics. The following topics are provided only as examples:

- The agricultural potential of Latin America: Implications for food supply and trade
- Consumer welfare and agribusiness development
- Climatic and environmental challenges facing Latin American agriculture
- Agribusiness development and trade
- Food safety and consumer welfare
- Technology adoption, climate change and resource management
- Sustainable land and water management
- Natural resource management and agricultural sustainability
- Farm size and productivity
- Climate change and food security along the value chain
- Policy options to stimulate sustainable agricultural production
- Nonmarket valuation and ecosystem services related to land use change and agricultural production

Abstracts of Selected **Individual Presentations** will be clustered into themes and then included into coherent sessions. We also welcome **Organized Sessions**, which will be submitted by an Organizer who will assemble a small group (3-4) presenters focusing on a well-defined topic.

The Abstracts for all Individual Presentations must be received by **Monday, April 20, 2020**, and submitted using Conftool, the Symposium's online System. All Abstracts will be reviewed in a double-blind review process.

The Abstract has to include:

* **Title Page** with names and institutional affiliations of all co-authors;; 3-5 keywords.

* **The Body of the Abstract** should start on a **separate page** and include: (i) Title; (ii) Brief Introduction; (iii) Main Research Question(s) and Contribution(s); (iv) Data and Methodology; (v) Key Results and Conclusions.

All Abstracts should be written in English using the following format: 1.5 spacing; Times New Roman Font 12; One-inch margins all around. The length of the Abstract should **NOT exceed 2 pages** (excluding Title Page, Tables, Figures and References).

Organized sessions:

Organized session are welcome in the aforementioned list of topics. The proposals should include

* **Title Page** with institutions organizing the session and the name and affiliation of the presenters; 3-5 keywords;

***The body** of the proposal should contain (i) Title of the session; (ii) Brief Introduction; (iii) Format of the session.

Organized session proposal should be written in English using the following format: 1.5 spacing; Times New Roman Font 12; One-inch margins all around. The length of the Abstract should **NOT exceed 1 page**.

Authors and Organizers **need to adhere** to all stated requirements.
